Housing Rehabilitation assistance may become available in your town. If you meet the requirements *you may be eligible for up to \$35,000* for making necessary repairs to your home. Rehabilitation work can include new roofs, windows, siding, weatherization, heating systems, septic installations, lead paint remediation or other necessary improvements to improve living conditions.

Housing improvements is one of many community development initiatives being developed or presently available for area residents. In addition to housing rehabilitation, Warren is considering improvements to Highland Street, North Brookfield is trying to advance infrastructure improvements in the East Side neighborhood and Brookfield is considering appropriate facilities for its seniors. 
