

Town of Warren – Police officer

This is a full time police officer position within the Warren Police Department. Hours and shift assignment are subject to seniority and staffing needs at the discretion and direction of the Chief of Police.

Eligibility: Candidates must be a United States citizen, at least 21 years old, and have a high school diploma or equivalent. All applicants must currently possess valid certification as a full time police officer by the Massachusetts Municipal Police Training Committee. Candidates must possess strong interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills, possess a valid Massachusetts driver's license and the ability to obtain a Massachusetts license to carry firearms. Preferences include an associate degree or higher in criminal justice, service in the United States military, or experience as a full time police officer.
